## **ASSOCIATE DEGREE**

- C. Grade Point Average (GPA): The minimum cumulative and major field GPA must be 2.0.
- Major Field: The student must meet the course requirements in the particular program of study as approved by an advisor.
- **Civics Exam:** Any student entering a public institution of higher education for the first time after July 2019 who is pursuing an associate's or bachelor's degree must pass the exam as required by the State of Missouri (Senate Bill 807, Section 170.013).

1. SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES

- : F. University Experience: A university experience (UE 100) course is required for all Missouri Southern degree-seeking students. UE 100 is also required for transfer students with fewer than 30 credit hours who have not completed an orientation course. Dual credit and credit-in-escrow are excluded.
