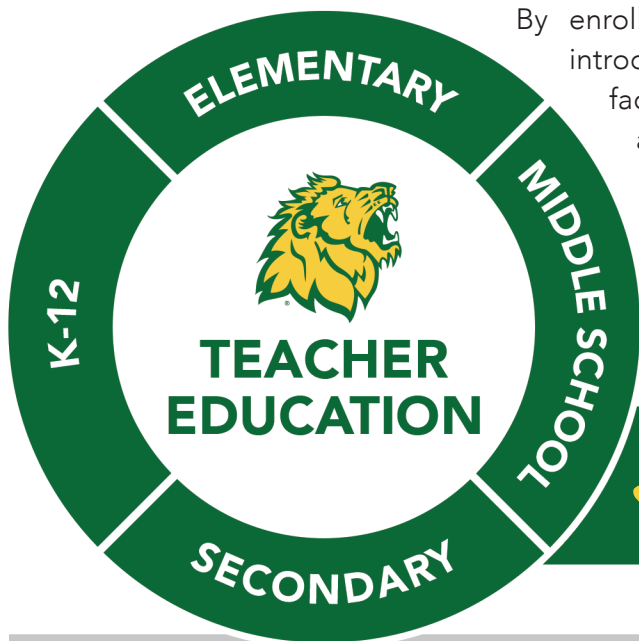


META MAJORS TEACHER EDUCATION PATHWAY

If you're interested in pursuing a degree in teacher education but haven't already decided on which area of certification to focus on, the Teacher Education Pathway is an excellent starting point.



By enrolling in this pathway, you'll gain exposure to important introductory education courses and connect with teacher education faculty and advisors. These opportunities will help you make an informed decision about the major that aligns with your interests and career goals.

The first year of the Teacher Education Pathway provides an understanding of some key foundational areas that will set you up for success.
